Founded in early 2020 by Greg Hyver, the **First Amendment Rights Preservation Society**, **Inc.**, or FARPS, is a nonpartisan, 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization based in Santa Cruz, California, that is committed to defending the spirit and laws that protect our most sacred right: the right to free speech. We are an organization of patriotic activists who use tools of activism to educate the public and advocate against those who abuse the freedom of speech rights of the weak and powerless. Our focus is on finding ways to remove speech barriers set up by local, state, national (and international) governmental entities to enable the oppressed to have an equal voice in the public forum.

Our raison d'être lies in our foundational belief that our representative

Making Democracies More Democratic!

Founded in 2023, **Democratic Software Solutions LLC**, or DSS, is a commercial spinoff of First Amendment Rights Preservation Society, Inc. and was the brainchild of the **E-Democracy Institute** think tank in 2022. DSS was not tasked to produce another social media platform, but to create an advanced, data-driven, consensus-modeling tool to give ordinary community members a genuine voice in how decisions are made for their local communities--decisions

routinely dictated to them by powerful, well-organized and hyper-funded political machines and their special interest partners, transforming our cities into their visions, not those of the residents. The result--a web-based tool called **ECHO**, paired with the proprietary **E-Democracy™** software engine, that deploys timely, concise, transparent and invaluable data messaging between resident and representative. Echo is a transformative, game-changing solution that makes "getting involved" in community politics "no longer a chore"--a place where free speech rights are tantamount to ensure a fairer and more pluralistic local government institution. In 2025, FARPS will pursue grant funding to run several pilot studies in local communities to determine the effectiveness of the ECHO software for advancing greater inclusion and retention of resident voices in the policy dialogue.

THE BENEVOLENT BEAN PROGRAM



Fusing Warm Beverages with Community Bridging to Deliver "Kindness-in-a-Cup" to the Santa Cruz Homeless Community

The Benevolent Bean is a charitable program designed to reduce some of the hardship that bears upon a homeless person each day. The Bean Mobile is an electric vehicle (aka "food truck") that circulates into areas with manageable concentrations of poorly-sheltered, homeless individuals lacking proximity to

equivalent services (e.g. nearby food distribution centers). The program delivers free, warm beverages (coffee, tea), from 8:00am – 10:00am each day. Its driver is responsible for navigating the Bean Mobile into homeless areas (targets) and serving the beverages to homeless patrons. The program is 100%-reliant on tax-deductible contributions from its donors. The Benevolent Bean program is still in its funding stage.
